- 2. Title of email Positive COVID result for (name of pupil and year group)
- 3. In your message please provide answers to the following questions:
  - When did the symptoms start?
  - When was your child last in school?
  - What was the date of the test?
  - What was the date when you received the positive result?

Any pupil contacts will be notified by letter via Email and text to self-isolate.

Your child tests positive between Thursday 23rd December – Monday 3rd January
